\$106,704,434 in deferred park maintenance

1,595 bridges, 9.1% of which were structurally deficient in 2019



6 major water ports

28 high hazard dams

17% of roads are in poor condition. Each motorist pays \$402 per year in costs due to driving on roads in need of repair

225 outages between 2008 and 2017



\$121 million gap in estimated school capital expenditures
