14 public use airports in North Carolina



\$459,049,042 in deferred park maintenance

18,407 bridges, **9.3%** of which were structurally deficient in 2019



2 major water ports

1,307 high hazard dams



3,161 miles of rail across the state

\$16.8 billion total drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years



14% of roads are in poor condition. Each motorist pays **\$500** per year in costs due to driving on roads in need of repair
