1,138 bridges, 7% of which were structurally deficient in 2019



6 major water ports

43% of roads are in poor condition. Each motorist pays \$818 per year in costs due to driving on roads in need of repair

\$1.2 billion total drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years



\$88 million gap in estimated school capital expenditures
