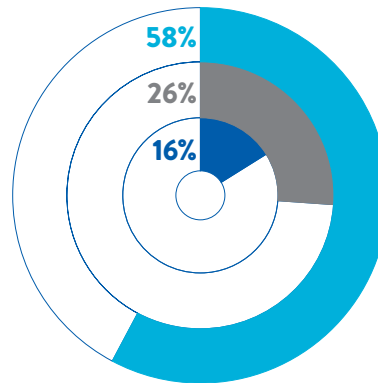
**47%** of roads are in poor or fair condition

## BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW

**\$5.6 billion**



has been distributed so far across **459 projects** (average \$12.7M, median \$663K)



- **58%** to transportation
- **26%** to climate/energy/environment
- **16%** for broadband

## KEY WINS IN COLORADO

- \$167M** for renewable power generation at Colorado School of Mines
- \$59M** for Denver International Airport
- \$18.7M** for broadband upgrades with the Eastern Slope Rural Telephone Assn
- \$500K** for brownfield remediation in the City of Lamar
