

BASIC FACTS

\$1 million in 2022 airport improvement grants across **4** major airports

4,361 bridges: **5.3%** of which were structurally deficient in 2021

283 high-hazard dams

\$4.9 billion total drinking water need

17 Superfund sites

21 miles of levees protect **\$3.4 billion** of property

24.2 million passenger trips across **22** systems in 2021

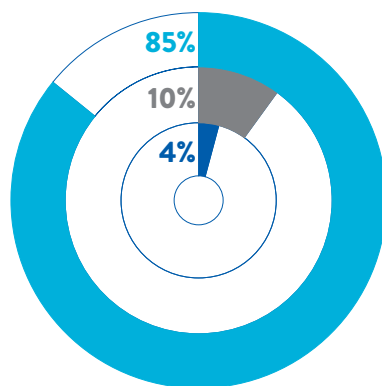
\$4.6 billion in wastewater needs

61% of roads are in poor or fair condition
Each motorist pays \$728 per year driving on roads in need of repair and every resident loses \$1,712 annually due to crashes

BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW

\$4 billion

has been distributed so far across **262 projects** (average \$15.4M, median \$1M)



- 85%** to transportation
- 10%** to climate/energy/environment
- 4%** for broadband
