2 of 3 nearby major airports walkable to high-frequency rail transit

246 bridges: **2.8%** of which were structurally deficient in 2021

No high-hazard dams

\$3.4 billion total drinking water need

No Superfund sites

One mile of levees protect **\$3.6 billion** of property

158 million passenger trips across **2** systems in 2022

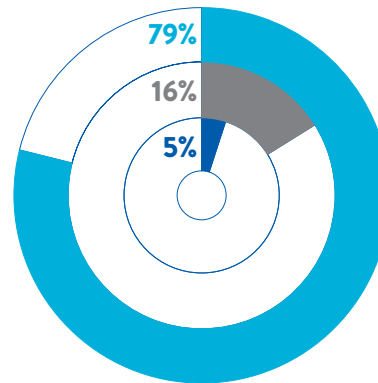
\$2.8 billion in wastewater needs

BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW

\$2.1 billion

has been distributed so far across **107 projects** (average \$19.6M, median \$5M)
