

BASIC FACTS

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Two major airports
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875 bridges: **1.9%** of which were structurally deficient in 2021
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57 high-hazard dams
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\$1.8 billion total drinking water need
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26 Superfund sites
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9 miles of levees protect **170** residents
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5.2 million passenger trips within one system in 2021
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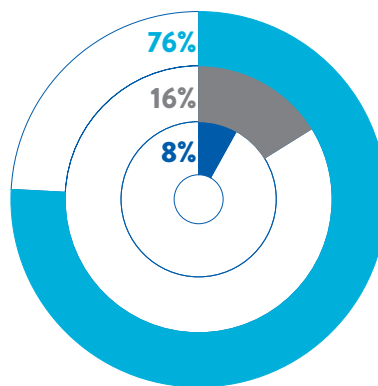
\$206 million in wastewater needs
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35% of roads are in poor or fair condition
Each motorist pays \$475 per year driving on roads in need of repair and every resident loses \$1,518 annually due to crashes

BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW

\$9.9 billion

has been distributed so far across **148 projects** (average \$1.4M, median \$1.6M)

- **16%** to climate/energy/environment
- **8%** for broadband
