
4 million passenger trips across **84** systems in 2021

Each motorist pays \$532 per year driving on roads in need of repair and every resident loses \$1,024 annually due to crashes


BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW

\$3.1 billion has been distributed so far across **384 projects** (average \$8.1M, median \$292K)

-  **66%** to transportation
-  **17%** to climate/energy/environment
-  **17%** for broadband

KEY WINS IN KANSAS



- \$22.1M** to replace the Old Smoky Hill River Bridge in Salina
- \$13.9M** for Tuttle Creek Lake in Pottawatomie County
- \$3M** for broadband deployment in rural NE Kansas
- \$500K** to Flint Hills Regional Council for brownfields improvements
