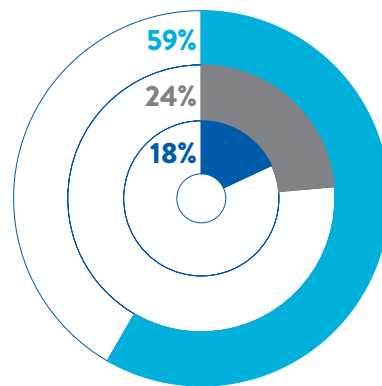

BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW

\$6.4 billion

has been distributed so far across **369 projects** (average \$17.7M, median \$490K)



- **59%** to transportation
- **24%** to climate/energy/environment
- **18%** for broadband

KEY WINS IN KENTUCKY

- \$465M** for Kentucky Lock and Dam in Grand Rivers
- \$17.3M** for Rockport Bridge Rehabilitation Freight Rail Project
- \$5M** for Broadway transit and safety improvements in Louisville
- \$500K** to Cumberland Valley Area Development District for brownfields
