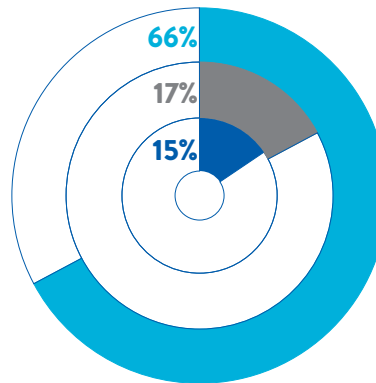

BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW

\$2 billion

has been distributed so far across **303 projects** (average \$6.7M, median \$540K)



- **66%** to transportation
- **17%** to climate/energy/environment
- **15%** for broadband

KEY WINS IN MAINE

- \$33M** for Downeast Coastal US 1 Rehab Project in Washington County
- \$14.2M** for Bangor International Airport
- \$1M** to revolving loan fund for Androscoggin Valley Council of Governments
- \$350K** for brownfield remediation in Millinocket
