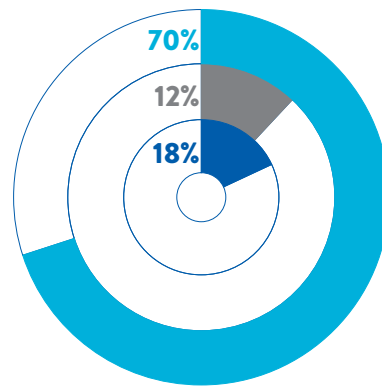

BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW
