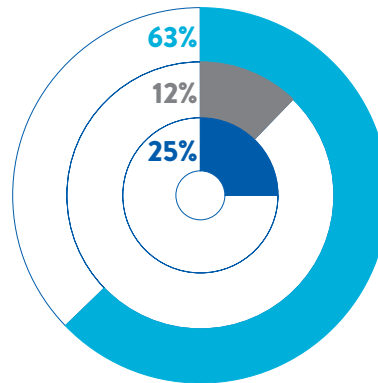

## BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW

**\$7.9 billion**

has been distributed so far across **464 projects** (average \$17.1M, median \$429K)



- **63%** to transportation
- **12%** to climate/energy/environment
- **25%** for broadband

## KEY WINS IN MISSOURI

- \$197M** to St. Louis for production of lithium battery inputs
- \$16M** for St Louis Lambert International Airport
- \$6.4M** for Truman Dam and Reservoir in Benton County
- \$850K** to Kansas City for brownfield improvements
