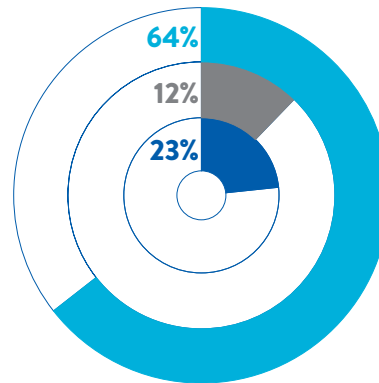
\$2.4 billion in wastewater needs

BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW

\$5.2 billion

has been distributed so far across **560 projects** (average \$9.5M, median \$295K)



- **64%** to transportation
- **12%** to climate/energy/environment
- **23%** for broadband
