

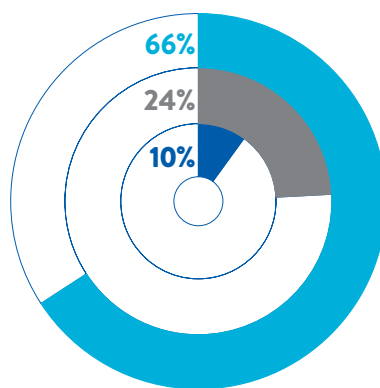

BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW
