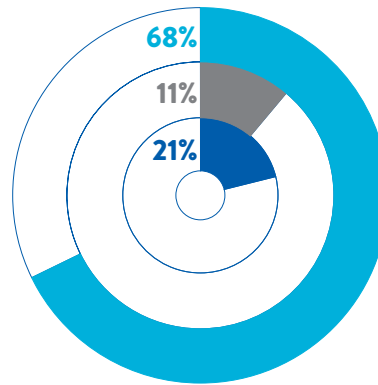

BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW

\$5.6 billion

has been distributed so far across **528 projects** (average \$10.9M, median \$292K)



- **68%** to transportation
- **11%** to climate/energy/environment
- **21%** for broadband

KEY WINS IN WISCONSIN

- \$80M** to the I-39/90/94 Wisconsin River Bridges Project in Columbia County
- \$8M** for broadband within the Red Cliff Band of Lake Superior Chippewa
- \$3.5M** to water revolving loan fund for the City of West Allis
- \$295K** to the Baraboo-Wisconsin Dells Regional Airport
