

Each motorist pays **\$816** per year driving on roads in need of repair and every resident loses **\$1,524** annually due to crashes.


FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS

\$8.2 billion has been announced so far across **873 projects** (average \$9.6M, median \$748K)

- **59%** for transportation
- **12%** for clean water
- **13%** for broadband
- **5%** for clean energy/buildings
- **2%** for environmental remediation
- **8%** for resilience
