

Each motorist pays **\$281** per year driving on roads in need of repair and every resident loses **\$815** annually due to crashes.


FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS

\$3.5 billion has been announced so far across **675 projects** (average \$5.4M, median \$465K)

- **60%** for transportation
- **10%** for clean water
- **18%** for broadband
- **3%** for clean energy/buildings
- **0.2%** for environmental remediation
- **8%** for resilience
