

Each motorist pays **\$259** per year driving on roads in need of repair and every resident loses **\$1,709** annually due to crashes.


FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS

\$8.6 billion has been announced so far across **687 projects** (average \$12.7M, median \$500K)

- **73%** for transportation
- **9%** for clean water
- **13%** for broadband
- **2%** for clean energy/buildings
- **2%** for environmental remediation
- **2%** for resilience
