**\$30.6 million**  
in 2024 Airport Improvement grants across **8** major airports
- 

**24,894** bridges: **5.3%** of which were structurally deficient in 2024


**6.6 million** passenger trips across **85** systems in 2023

**14%** of roads are in poor or fair condition.  
Each motorist pays **\$306** per year driving on roads in need of repair and every resident loses **\$1,191** annually due to crashes.

### FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS

**\$4.2 billion** has been announced so far across **666 projects** (average \$6.4M, median \$355K)

- **67%** for transportation
- **9%** for clean water
- **14%** for broadband
- **4%** for clean energy/buildings
- **3%** for environmental remediation
- **3%** for resilience

for broadband deployment in rural NE Kansas
