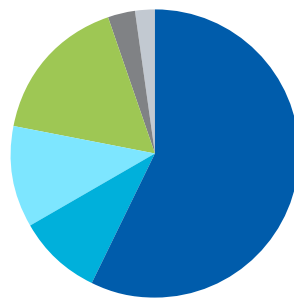


39% of roads are in poor or fair condition.

FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS
