

Each motorist pays **\$990** per year driving on roads in need of repair and every resident loses **\$1,527** annually due to crashes.


FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS

\$10.3 billion has been announced so far across **760 projects** (average \$13.6M, median \$458K)

- **65%** for transportation
- **6%** for clean water
- **21%** for broadband
- **4%** for clean energy/buildings
- **1.5%** for environmental remediation
- **2%** for resilience
