

### BASIC FACTS

**\$52.8 million**  
in 2024 Airport Improvement grants across **4** major airports

**22,917** bridges: **7.7%** of which were structurally deficient in 2024

**444** high-hazard dams

**\$9.7 billion** total drinking water need

**18** Superfund sites

**100** miles of levees protect **17,000** residents

**7.7 million** passenger trips across **36** systems in 2023

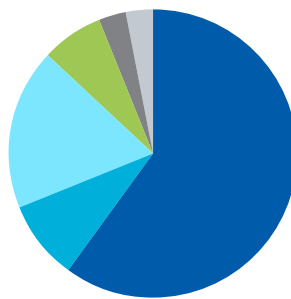
**\$1.7 billion** in wastewater needs

**28%** of roads are in poor or fair condition.  
Each motorist pays **\$508** per year driving on roads in need of repair and every resident loses **\$1,136** annually due to crashes.

### FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS

**\$7.9 billion**

has been announced so far across **1,187 projects** (average \$6.7M, median \$333K)



- **60%** for transportation
- **9%** for clean water
- **18%** for broadband
- **7%** for clean energy/buildings
- **3%** for environmental remediation
- **3%** for resilience
