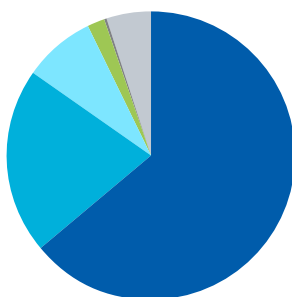


34% of roads are in poor or fair condition.
Each motorist pays **\$672** per year driving on roads in need of repair and every resident loses **\$1,578** annually due to crashes.

FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS

\$3.3 billion

has been announced so far across **691 projects** (average \$4.8M, median \$343K)



- **65%** for transportation
- **21%** for clean water

- **0.3%** for environmental remediation
