
206 million passenger trips across **76** systems in 2021

48% of roads are in poor or fair condition.
Each motorist pays \$948 per year driving on roads in need of repair and every resident loses \$1,427 annually due to crashes.

FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS

\$38.7 billion has been announced so far across **1,703 projects** (average \$22.9M, median \$500K)

- **68%** for transportation
- **10%** for clean energy/buildings
- **5%** for clean water
- **0.9%** for environmental remediation
- **12%** for broadband
- **4%** for resilience
