
43.5 million passenger trips across **78** systems in 2023

45% of roads are in poor or fair condition.
Each motorist pays **\$865** per year driving on roads in need of repair and every resident loses **\$1,323** annually due to crashes.

FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS

\$8.2 billion has been announced so far across **995 projects** (average \$8.3M, median \$294K)

- **64%** for transportation
- **13%** for clean water
- **17%** for broadband
- **3%** for clean energy/buildings
- **0.4%** for environmental remediation
- **2%** for resilience

KEY WINS IN WISCONSIN

- \$80M** to the I-39/90/94 Wisconsin River Bridges Project in Columbia County
- \$8M** for broadband within the Red Cliff Band of Lake Superior Chippewa
- \$3.5M** to water revolving loan fund for the City of West Allis
- \$295K** to the Baraboo-Wisconsin Dells Regional Airport
