# FLORIDA INFRASTRUCTURE FACTS



## IIJA Funded Projects

### Venetian Causeway Bridge Replacement Project:

This \$101 million award will replace 11 aging Venetian Causeway bridges in Miami-Dade County with modern, resilient infrastructure designed to last 50 years, resulting in improved safety and reliability for travelers.

### Florida Panhandle Rail Resiliency and Connectivity Project:

This \$23.1 million award will fund rail infrastructure and safety improvements along a 100-mile stretch of the Florida Gulf & Atlantic Railroad's mainline in the panhandle, resulting in expanded operating capacity and enhanced safety in a region frequently impacted by severe hurricanes.

### I-4 West Central Florida Truck Parking Facility:

This \$15 million award will build a new truck parking facility with approximately 120 spaces, electric charging stations, and pedestrian infrastructure to access nearby amenities, resulting in improved safety and convenience along a corridor between Tampa and Orlando that carries an average of 18,000 trucks daily but currently lacks sufficient parking.
