INDIANA INFRASTRUCTURE FACTS



IIJA Funded Projects

Ridge Road Complete Streets Project:

This \$17.1 million award will reconfigure a 1.3-mile stretch of Ridge Road from five lanes to three, resulting in improved safety and mobility through the addition of a 10-foot-wide multi-use path, more than 250 trees, and amenities such as landscaping, wayfinding signage, and pedestrian seating.

Indianapolis Public Transportation Operations and Maintenance Facility:

This \$33 million award will build a multi-purpose operations and maintenance facility that will also serve as the agency's headquarters, resulting in improved efficiency and support for public transit operations in Indianapolis.

Great Lakes Restoration Initiative:

This \$1 billion award will clean up and restore the Great Lakes' most environmentally degraded sites across six states, resulting in cleaner water and a healthier environment for millions of Americans. In Indiana, the investment will prioritize restoration of the Grand Calumet River.
