PUERTO RICO INFRASTRUCTURE FACTS



IIJA Funded Projects

Caño Martín Peña Project:


This \$163 million award will dredge approximately 2.2 miles of the Caño Martín Peña canal, stabilize the shoreline, and plant about 35 acres of mangroves, resulting in improved water flow, enhanced ecosystem resilience, and reduced flood risk for surrounding communities.

PR-2 Improvements:

This \$90 million award will reconfigure a 1.4-mile segment of PR-2 in Mayaguez, improving roadway and intersections to enhance safety for transit users, pedestrians, and cyclists in historically disadvantaged communities.

Wharf C Repairs:

This \$25 million award will repair and improve Wharf C, including replacing a damaged platform to support heavier cargo loads, restoring functionality after Hurricane Maria.



As of January 2025,
\$2.6 billion
has been distributed across Puerto Rico from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, funding
319 projects.
