# SOUTH CAROLINA INFRASTRUCTURE FACTS



## IIJA Funded Projects

### I-95 over Lake Marion Bridge Replacement Project:

This \$175 million award will replace four aging bridges over Lake Marion on I-95, reducing congestion and maintenance costs while improving safety along this critical north-south corridor.

### Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway:

This \$12.6 million award will fund improvements to South Carolina's segment of the Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway, strengthening regional supply chains and supporting efficient freight movement.

### Railroad Corner Redevelopment:

This \$22 million award will construct a pedestrian bridge over two state highways and a railroad, along with a multimodal transit hub, EV and bicycle charging infrastructure, and a public parking structure, improving connections between residential neighborhoods, university campuses, and downtown Orangeburg.
