# TENNESSEE INFRASTRUCTURE FACTS



## IIJA Funded Projects

### America's River Crossing Project:

This \$394 million award will replace the 75-year-old I-55 bridge over the Mississippi River, adding capacity and improving design to strengthen this nationally significant corridor for commerce and ensure safe, efficient connections for residents, workers, and freight between Tennessee, Arkansas, and Mississippi.

### Memphis Area Transit Authority Facility:

This \$54 million award will build a new operations and maintenance facility capable of accommodating more than 300 vehicles, improving transit service efficiency and reliability.

### Tennessee Transportation Capital Improvements:

This \$24 million award will rehabilitate or replace 42 bridges across 10 short line railroads in Tennessee, improving rail infrastructure and safety to support efficient freight movement.
